

2024 Behavior Frontiers Helen Mader Scholarship

Regulations Governing the Granting of Scholarships:

Scholarship(s) shall be awarded annually to financially assist sophomore or junior college students pursuing a degree in Child Development, Special Education, Psychology, or minoring/emphasis in Applied Behavior Analysis. Behavior Frontiers is about creating new opportunities for children and their families to help them reach important milestones in ABA treatment and Autism care. The purpose of our Behavior Frontiers Helen Mader Scholarship is to inspire young college students to pursue a career field they love and one day make an impact in the lives of others. The Behavior Frontiers Helen Mader Scholarship does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national and ethnic origin in the administration of its scholarship program. Scholarships will be awarded for the 2024-2025 academic year and awards will be paid directly to the institution for scholastic purposes. **Scholarship in the amount of \$1,500 will be awarded to three selected students.**

Qualifications:

This scholarship is to help college students financially so they can afford a proper education. Students must be enrolled as a sophomore or junior at any California College (Cal State, Community College, UC, University).

In order to qualify for this scholarship, the candidate must be enrolled as a student at any California based college in their sophomore or junior year and must also:

- Carry a minimum GPA of 3.0
- Enrolled as a Sophomore or Junior majoring in Child Development, Special Education, Psychology, or minoring/emphasis in Applied Behavior Analysis.

Applications must include:

1. A current document that shows your accumulative GPA
2. A written application of 1,000 words or less on why you decided to pursue a degree in Child Development, Special Education, Psychology, or ABA and why they should be the one awarded the scholarship.

Applications must be received electronically by January 31, 2024 at 11:59PM.
